

We enjoy the freedom of creating sessions and activities that are not readily available or deemed 'the norm' in an LD provision.


Our centres are creative, expressive and communal, they are busy and loud environments which all needs to be taken into consideration when choosing a service thats right for you.

We now support more than 90 individuals over our 3.5 centres within the week, across a vast array of sessions which encourage independence, create life skills, develop social skills all whilst building on learning.





GLAM & GLOW

Hair & Beauty Salon

We brought work experience to us! Here at The Helping Hands Group we have created fully functional hair and beauty salons, right inside our centres. Massage, nail art, foot spa's, hair wash and blow dry's... You name it, you can get it at Glam & Glow.

Individuals take it in turns to work shifts as members of staff completing the treatments or being a customer and receiving the treatment themselves, thus combining relaxing treatments alongside work experience.



What Makes Charford Different?

Charford House was the first site opened by THHG back in 2011.

Welcoming, open space and wheelchair friendly! Charford also offers a quiet enclosed outdoor space to unwind under the gazebo or to complete some outdoor games.

Featuring a trampoline and paddling pool for those sunny days! It offers individuals the space to complete some horticulture tasks.

Our large 6 seater jacuzzi, with a ceiling hoist to allow access for all is a real gem in Charford's Arsenal.

There's nothing better than having a hot dip with the bubbles on..

Our newly opened Glam & Glow beauty salon, offers a wide range of treatments such as hair wash/cuts/blow dry/style and It's own nail bar to be pampered.

Appointments are a must, because of the popularity!

Our kitchen space incorporates a variety of switch lead equipment allowing all service users to access it!

Working on weekly recipes for cooking and baking. If you're lucky you might get some brought home to try!

Our large sensory room, fitted with a teddy chair, a bed and multiple bean bags is lit by beautiful LEDs, and sensory lights. We also focus on aromatherapy to stimulate the senses, it's the perfect place if you need a moment alone or to unwind with friends... We also have some chill out room upstairs, again allowing all individuals a safe space to access if needed.

Studio X is a huge space to allow creative minds to run free , with as much art resources you could ever need!

We work on 2 monthly projects such as mosaics, printing and pottery!

Our Newly refurbished theatre room gives everyone the opportunity to be the star of the show! Fitted out with a stage, wireless mics and its own sound system, it gives us a great space to practice our end of year show performances.


At Charford we focus on giving back to the community through our citizenship sessions by volunteering, giving back to those in need (hats for premature babies/boxes for the homeless).
